Georgia O’Keeffe Museum www.okeeffemuseum.org Our personal favorite. If you love art and/or specifically love the art of Georgia O’Keeffe this is a must visit that captures the wonderful story of the famed artist and her love for New Mexico. Located in the Santa Fe Plaza.

Best Shopping – The Santa Fe plaza has a wide array of shops specializing in everything Southwestern/Native American. On most days indigenous peoples from surrounding pueblos can be found showing and selling their jewelry on the north side of the plaza. (note, their jewelry is generally more reasonable in price and great quality)
